National Director's Note

This is information about FMCA and Family RV Associations Code of Ethics which is attached. It is our responsibility to honor and follow the Code of Ethics.



FMCA MEMBER CODE OF ETHICS

Every member of FMCA, as defined in the Bylaws, accepts and agrees that a condition of said membership is the obligation to abide by the FMCA Member Code of Ethics and the other rules and standards of this organization, which represent all our endeavors to be good neighbors, careful and responsible recreational vehicle owners and operators, and good citizens of our communities.

Consistent adherence to the FMCA Member Code of Ethics is desired and required of every member, in order that the actions of all members may reflect favorably upon each other and upon FMCA; and thereby earn the confidence and respect of the public and its acceptance of FMCA and all its members.

FMCA Member Personal Responsibilities:

- > Respect the rights and privacy of other members and recreational vehicle owners on and off the highways.
- > Comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations governing the ownership and use of recreational vehicles.
- > Obtain permission to remain overnight, in a shopping center parking lot or on other private property, from the owner or responsible party of the property.
- > Comply with all rules of national, state, municipal, and private facilities in which a member stays.
- > Last but not least, members should not lose sight of the fact that there is a universal guideline known as the Golden Rule that directs all proper endeavors.

Therefore, recognizing that the public will judge all recreational vehicle owners by their individual actions, all members of FMCA, as well as its employed personnel, are enjoined to honor and comply with the FMCA Member Code of Ethics.

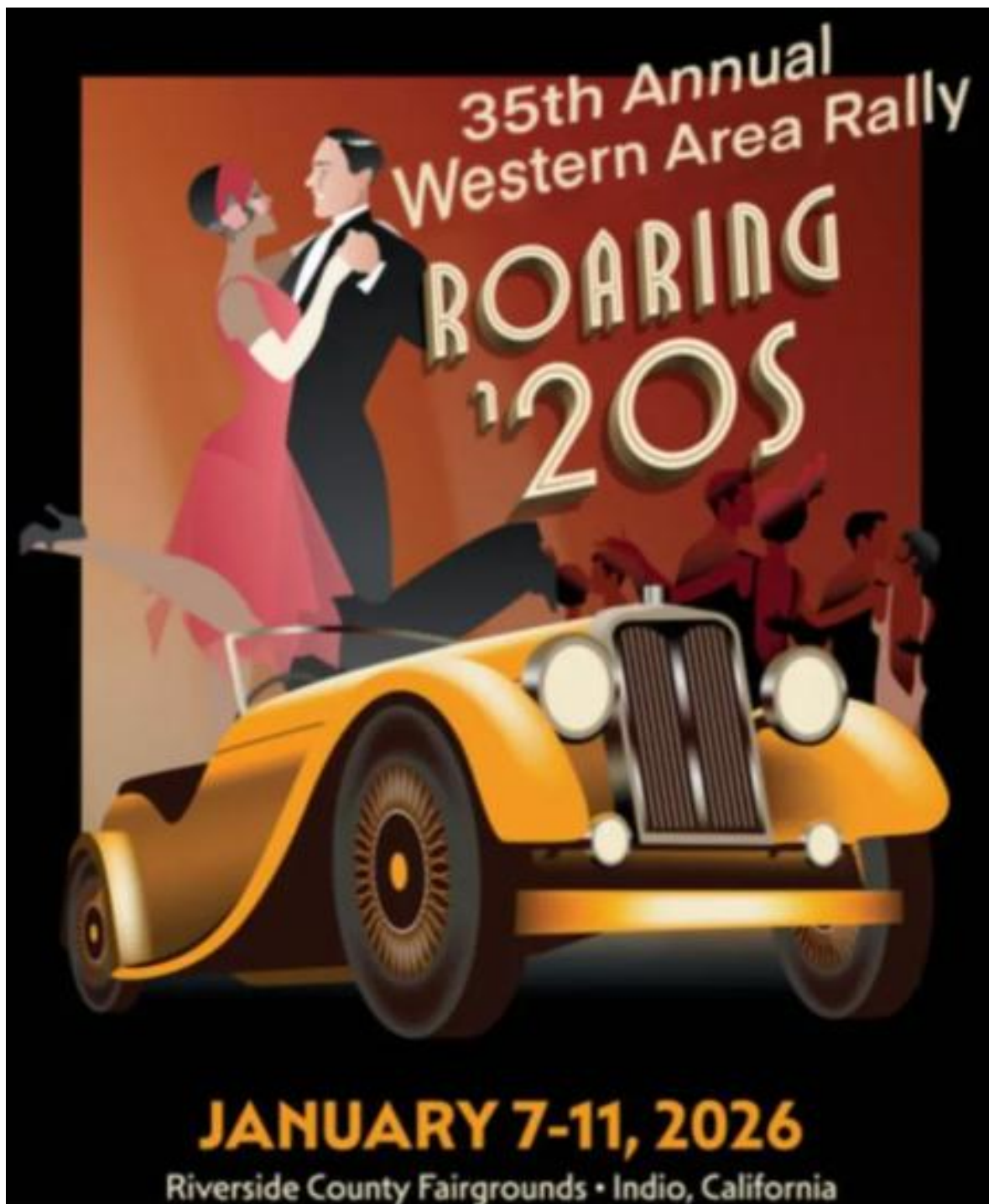

Gail Patrick Oberhoffer (Known by most as “Obey” - pronounced “OH-bee”) passed away on October 30th, 2025; he was 83 years old

Obey was born March 17th, 1942 in Dubuque, Iowa to Carl J. Oberhoffer and Marjorie (Piltz) Oberhoffer. He was raised in a large Catholic family with five brothers and two sisters.

As a youngster, he was an active boy scout with a passion for adventure. After High School, he received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Northeast Missouri State College and pursued many different careers including teaching (PE & Drivers Education), working for Braniff airlines, and working in Europe.

He married Christine Ennis on August 15th, 1981 at John XXIII Catholic Church, and settled in Fort Collins, Colorado. Together, they raised two children.

During those 44 years he worked in Sales, Marketing and Management for four different companies, then built a commercial warehouse and owned and operated his own business for many years. After selling his business, he continued as a warehouse landlord until his death.

Obey's passion for travel and adventure throughout his lifetime enabled him to set foot on every continent but Antarctica. He remained active in scouting with both children. The last 18 years of his life, he enjoyed traveling in his motor home through the United States, Canada, parts of Europe and Africa with his wife. He was an active member in Roadtrek International chapter of Family Recreational Vehicle Association among other organizations.

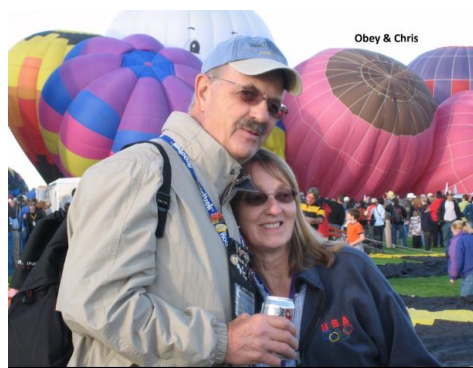
