The new website is now the primary site and the FRVA app is no longer functioning. So delete the FRVA app if you have downloaded it. You all need to take a look at FRVA.com. When you open it you will be asked to put in your email address and then setup a new user name and password. Remember that the website is still under development and you may need to call Cincinnati (800-543-3622) for assistance. But, when it is fully operational it's going to be great for individuals and chapter officers. The completed website is scheduled to be up and running in time for the 113th International Convention & RV Expo Sedalia, MO.

If you are going to attend FRVA's International Convention & RV Expo, no matter where it is being held, you can use an app called Cvent. By installing Cvent Event App (Found in the Apple App store or Google Play store) a week or two ahead of the rally you can download the booklet that you receive in your welcoming package. You now can plan what seminars you want to attend, have a portable map, see the entertainment schedule, where things are among others information

Finding you and your friends contact information

Would you like to verify the information we have on you is current? Or did you meet another Roadtreker at a rally and would like to contact them?

As a member of Roadtrek International Chapter you have access to the member list under the Members Access section (bottom, right side of www.roadtrekchapter.org/) .

In the email members get from us each other month is the id and password for the member Access section.

Once in the Member section look down the left side for “Membership List”. Click on it. There you will find 4 documents you can download. One shows which states and provinces belong to which region. The other three contain lists of members arranged in different orders (by Region, Last name, and FRVA number). All three list contain the same information, just arranged differently.

So, what is on the list? Besides name, address, phone and email, the list has the month and year your Roadtrek membership expires, and the Aide members are willing to give. Many of our members have offered to assist with mechanical problems, welcome phone calls when in the area, welcomes visits, (but call first) and/or are willing to share their Internet access. From personal experience, we have had problems a few times when we were far away from home. Talking to a local Roadtreker helped us find a repair service.

PARKING AREA DESCRIPTIONS

General Parking – Use of generator permitted from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Full Generator – Generator use permitted 24 hours a day.

No Generator – Generator use not permitted. Limited.

Electric Parking – Electric (30-amp or 50-amp) will be available at your parking space when you arrive.

Disabled Parking – The Disabled Lot will include 30-amp and 50-amp. Those who register for other types of service will be parked as close as possible to the activity areas.

Passport And Public Gate Car Parking – No overnight parking on event site property. Passport and Public Gate RVs cannot be accommodated at the grounds. The Passport and Public Gate car parking lot will be open from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., June 30-July 4, 2026.

FRVA PAYMENT PLAN

The FRVA Payment Plan is available for those who register by phone or web using a credit card. This plan allows registrants to pay half of the total registration cost upon initial registration, with the balance charged at a later date. For the Sedalia convention, the remaining balance will be charged on April 27, 2026.

MOBILITY CART/GOLF CART INSURANCE & USE

Attendees must have valid insurance on personal mobility carts and/or golf carts. All golf carts must have operating headlights if used before sunrise or after sunset. The speed limit for all vehicles in the activity areas is 5 mph.

CONFIRMATION NUMBER AND PARKING PROCEDURES FOR ALL PARKING AREAS

All registered guests must display their Confirmation Number in the motorhome or towing vehicle windshield to facilitate your entry onto the grounds.

Family RV Association will email your Confirmation Number and arrival date information in May. Please provide an email address that you regularly check so that you will receive your arrival information. All attendees will receive an email with their Confirmation Number to print and display in the windshield; a summary of your registration; and a Confirmation booklet with arrival information and directions.

WELCOME AREA

The Welcome Area will be open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, June 28, through Tuesday, June 30.

PARKING

Parking will be located at Missouri State Fairgrounds. Each RV will be parked with the assistance of a parking team member; no exceptions. Parking hours will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. All parking will be at the discretion of the parkers.

Registered family members will be assigned a parking date of Monday or Tuesday, June 29 or 30, 2026. Families are requested to arrive on the date stated on the email they receive. When registering, please advise if you cannot arrive on one of the assigned parking dates.

PARKING TOGETHER

If you would like to park with family or friends, you must register for the same type of parking and have the same arrival date. You must arrive together or wait in the Welcome Area until all parties have arrived to be parked.

CARAVANS

Groups of 10 or more RVs wishing to park together must register as a caravan with FRVA's Events Department by June 3, 2026. Please have the designated caravan leader call (800) 543-3622 and ask for the Events Department to make the reservation. Contact information, the number of RVs, and the type of parking will be needed at the time of the call. To park together, RVs in the caravan must register for the same type of parking.

EARLY ARRIVALS

If you arrive prior to the arrival date listed in your Confirmation Number email, dry camping will be available in the Welcome Area starting Saturday, June 27, at no charge. If you arrive early and would like to be parked in your final parking site (during scheduled parking hours), you will pay an additional \$40 per night (payable on-site; cash or check).

DEPARTURE

Departure is by noon on July 5, 2026, if you are not registered for the Midwest Area Rally that will be held July 5-6. If you are registered for the Midwest Area Rally, your departure is by noon on Tuesday, July 7.
